Re: Residential Parking

Please remember that Residential Parking is enforced from 9:00 am-4:00 pm Monday through Friday.

There is no enforcement on weekends and holidays.

If you are in need of a residential sticker, please come to the Town Clerk's Office at the Secaucus Municipal Center at 1203 Paterson Plank Road, Second Floor, during business hours of 9:00am- 4:00pm, Monday through Friday. Driver's License and Registration need to be provided along with proof of residency.

If you are having a visitor and require a Visitor Parking Permit, please come to the Town Clerk's Office with a Driver's License reflecting your Secaucus address and a permit to be used within a four (4) blocks your home, will be issued.

Please remember that commercial vehicles are not permitted on residential streets from 12:00 am to 6:00 am.

Vehicles without residential permits are allowed to park on residential streets for up to 2 or 4 hours depending on the particular street and posted signage.
