AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 127-58B OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "DESIGNATION OF LOCATIONS AT OR NEAR PRIVATE RESIDENCES"

SECTION 1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus that Section 127-58B - "Designation of Locations at or Near Private Residences" shall be amended by deleting the following location:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Seventh Street	West	On the west side of Seventh Street, beginning at a point 420 feet south of the southwest corner of Seventh Street and Centre Avenue continuing south for a distance of 22 feet in front of 711 Seventh Street

SECTION 2

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus that Section 127-58B - "Designation of Locations at or Near Private Residences" shall be amended by adding the following locations:

That the parking space designated for 1467 Paterson Plank Road adopted by Ordinance is to be personalized for Placard Number P2055382.

SECTION 3

SEVERABILITY

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the provisions of this ordinance are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of the regulation or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and if such persons or circumstances, to which the ordinance or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempted therefrom.

SECTION 4

REPEALER

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5

EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 28 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF
SECAUCUS ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT" TO UPDATE COMPOSITION
TO REFLECT DEPARTMENT NEEDS**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, upon recommendation of the Police Chief, have determined that changes to the Ordinance entitled "Police Department" shall be made to account for the current personnel needs of the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 28 entitled "Police Department," "§28-3. Composition of Department." of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**, deletions indicated by ~~strikethroughs~~):

The Police Department of the Town of Secaucus shall consist of no more than:

- A. One Chief of Police;
- B. One Deputy Chief of Police;
- C. Three Captains;
- D. ~~Eight~~ **Ten** Lieutenants;
- E. ~~Fifteen~~ **Fourteen** Sergeants; and
- F. ~~Fifty~~ **Fifty-five** Police Officers.

The Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police, Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants, and Police Officers shall be appointed to these positions by resolution of the Mayor and Council.

2. There are no other changes to this Chapter of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of this Chapter 28 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus shall remain in full force and effect.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 127A OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF
SECAUCUS ENTITLED "RESIDENTIAL PARKING" TO CLARIFY BUSINESS
PERMIT PARKING USE**

WHEREAS, the Town has a business parking program under §127A-1 *et seq.* that was developed to alleviate unfavorable parking conditions and address the issuance of parking permits around the Plaza Center and other business areas; and

WHEREAS, upon review by the Secaucus Police Traffic Division and the Legal Department, clarification as to paid parking requirements when displaying a valid business parking permit should be added.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 127A entitled "Residential Parking," §127A-8 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**, deletions are indicated by ~~crossouts~~):

§ 127A-8 Criteria and issuance of residential parking permits, **visitor permits, business parking permits and other permits.** ~~stickers and residential parking placards.~~

A. ...

(3) Business Parking Permits.

A person who owns or leases a commercial property and engages actively in a business within an area designated "Parking for Residents Only," may apply for a Business Parking Permit ...

Such permit shall identify the address of the business, expiration date and other identifying information as deemed appropriate by the Town Administrator, the Police Chief and/or their designee. The permit shall allow the holder to park in designated parking areas during specified time periods as determined by the Town Administrator and/or the Police Chief, as set forth below. **The permit shall allow the holder to park in designated parking areas during specified time periods without payment into a meter or paid parking station, if applicable for that designated area.**

2. There are no other changes to these sections of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that the remainder of this Chapter 127A of the Code of the Town of Secaucus shall remain in full force and effect.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:10A-1 et seq. sets forth the procedure for disposition of abandoned vehicles in the possession of a municipality and provides that when such vehicles remain unclaimed by the owner for a period of thirty (30) days, they may be sold at public auction in a public place. The public agency must give notice of the sale by certified mail, to the owner, if his/her name and address are known and to the holder of any security interest filed with the Chair and Chief Administrator of the Motor Vehicle Commission and by publication; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Secaucus intends to utilize the online auction services of GovDeals.com located at www.GovDeals.com through Sourcewell pursuant to **Resolution 2019-114**.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING
EXTENSION THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2021**

WHEREAS, the Governor's Executive No. Order 150 issued June 3, 2020; and subsequent Executive Orders, permit municipalities to exercise authority to allow "food or beverage establishments" to expand their footprint to outdoor areas, both privately and municipally owned, with operation in accordance with state guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of New Jersey pursuant to P.L. 2021, Chapter 15 (approved Feb. 5, 2021) has permitted restaurants, bars, distilleries and breweries to continue and/or expand outdoor dining in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus adopted **Resolution 2020-122** authorizing the issuance of "Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event Permits" for local food or beverage establishments within the Town of Secaucus' zoning boundaries for operation beginning June 15, 2020, in accordance with the Governor's COVID-19 plan and Executive Orders; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of such, the Mayor and Council also adopted **Resolution 2020-173** on July 28, 2020, extending the time limitation on certain dates; **Resolution 2020-177** on August 25, 2020, extending temporary outdoor dining permits through October 31, 2020; **Resolution 2020-272** on October 27, 2020, extending temporary outdoor dining permits through November 30, 2020; and **Resolution 2020-310**, extending temporary outdoor dining permits through March 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, numerous local food or beverage establishments have been issued "Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event Permits," and the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus want to further support local businesses and the local economy during this ongoing state by extending the outdoor dining option in accordance with the recent Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, upon a request for renewal of the zoning certificate and extension of outdoor dining, a renewal of the "Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event Permit" may be issued through November 30, 2021, or by further Order by the State of New Jersey, for local food or beverage establishments within the Town of Secaucus' zoning boundaries to operate outdoor dining in accordance with the Governor's current COVID-19 Executive Orders and legislation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other applicable federal, state and local regulations remain in effect and shall be enforced except that any Town Ordinance or regulation/policy in conflict with the purpose and intent of this Resolution shall be superseded until November 30, 2021, or until this Resolution is revoked, whichever is earlier; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the ABC designee is authorized to take any action necessary to effectuate this time extension for any local license holders involved, noting that pursuant to the State of New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control SR2020-21, COVID-19 Expansion Permits were renewed through March 31, 2021 and recent legislation extends the effective period of issued permits through the later of November 30, 2022 or when indoor dining returns to full capacity; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no fee will be required by the Town of Secaucus for the renewal of the Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event Permit, any UCC permit or other Construction Department required permits related to the outdoor dining extension during this period; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to further support local businesses, outdoor dining operations are permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Sunday through Thursday and from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays, in adherence with all capacity requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Town Administrator, or their designee are hereby authorized to take any action necessary to effectuate the spirit and purpose of this Resolution.
