ORDINANCE NO.2021-12

CALENDAR YEAR 2021 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 1.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Secaucus, in the County of Hudson, finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2021 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council hereby determines that a 2.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$1,172,820.70 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and Town Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Secaucus, in the County of Hudson, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2021 budget year, the final appropriations of the Town of Secaucus shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$1,641,948.98, and that the CY 2021 municipal budget for the Town of Secaucus be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 127-58B OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "DESIGNATION OF LOCATIONS AT OR NEAR PRIVATE RESIDENCES"

SECTION 1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus that Section 127-58B - "Designation of Locations at or Near Private Residences" shall be amended by <u>deleting</u> the following location:

Seventh Street	West	On the west side of Seventh Street, 180 feet south of the northwest corner of Flanagan Way and Seventh Street continuing south for a distance of 18 feet in front of 847 Seventh Street

SECTION 2

SEVERABILITY

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the provisions of this ordinance are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of the regulation or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and if such persons or circumstances, to which the ordinance or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempted therefrom.

SECTION 3

REPEALER

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4

EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law. ORDINANCE NO. 2021-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES" TO ADD EMPLOYMENT TITLES FOR THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT AND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the Town Code Chapter 23 creates and specifies the Offices, Positions, Appointment, Qualifications, Powers and Duties within the Town of Secaucus; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2021-15, amending Chapter 23 of the code of the Town of Secaucus entitled "Officers and Employees" to add employment titles for various departments, was introduced at the Town Council meeting of May 11, 2021, and is set for adoption at the Town Council meeting of June 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the following Finance Department title and Department of Public Works title were inadvertently left out of the introduction of Ordinance 2021-15 and are being recommended as additions by the Human Resources Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 23 entitled "Officers and Employees," <u>Article II, Employees</u> of the Code of the Town of Sceaucus is hereby supplemented as follows:

Subsection ____. Fiscal Analyst / Financial Assistant

§23-__Creation. There is hereby created the position of Fiscal Analyst / Financial Assistant.

§23-___Appointment, Term of Office. The Fiscal Analyst / Financial Assistant shall be appointed by the Mayor and Council. The term of office of the Fiscal Analyst / Financial Assistant shall be at the pleasure of the Mayor and Council.

§23-___ Duties. The Fiscal Analyst / Financial Assistant shall perform such duties as are assigned from time to time by the Mayor and Council, Town Administrator, the Chief Financial Officer and/or the Director of Finance/Treasurer.

§23-__Compensation. The salary of the Fiscal Analyst / Financial Assistant shall be as set forth in the annual Salary Ordinance.

Subsection ___. Laborer

§23- Creation. There is hereby created the position of Laborer.

§23-__ Appointment, Term of Office. The Mayor and Council shall appoint, from time to time, as many Laborer as deemed necessary. The term of the Laborer/Driver 2 shall be at the pleasure of the Mayor and Council.

§23-___ Duties. The Laborer shall perform such duties as are assigned from time to time by the Mayor and Council, Town Administrator, the Superintendent of Public Works and/or any other appropriate supervisor.

§23-__Compensation. The salary of the Laborer shall be as set forth in the annual Salary Ordinance.

- 2. Any action needed to re-number this Chapter is hereby permitted as the additions may alter the current set-up of Chapter 23.
- 3. There are no other changes to this Chapter of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
- 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- 5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
- 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
