WHEREAS, LawSoft Inc. has provided a quote for these services in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five Dollars (\$19,995.00); and

WHEREAS, LawSoft Inc. is the sole source vendor that can provide support and maintenance to the LawSoft CAD/RMS System software, and LawSoft CAS/RMS is a copyrighted, trademarked product fully owned and operated by LawSoft Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council for the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, award the contract for Support and Maintenance for the LawSoft CAD/RMS System for an amount not to exceed Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five Dollars (\$19,995.00); and

WHEREAS, the Secaucus Police Department has the need to continue the services of maintaining and staying updated on the NJSACOP Accreditation; and

WHEREAS, a contract with The Rodgers Group was awarded under Resolution 2019-103 for a three-year accreditation cycle; and

WHEREAS, the Rodgers Group, LLC is a "Professional Service" experienced in Oversight and Direct Mentorship of the Process of Securing NJSACOP Re-accreditation for New Jersey Police Departments; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires that the resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection; and

IN BLOCK 99, QUALIFIER HM AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL TAX
MAPS OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS OWNED BY SKAD ENTERPRISES.

WHEREAS, Skad Enterprises, the owner of real property located at 734 County Avenue, otherwise designated as Lot 4 in Block 99, Qualifier HM on the official tax maps of the Town of Secaucus, has taken appeals to the Tax Court of the State of New Jersey from the assessed valuations upon said property for the 2017, 2018 and 2019 Tax Years; and

WHEREAS, the Complaint filed for 2019 (Docket No. 000255-2019) shall be withdrawn along with the Town's withdrawal of its Counterclaim; and

WHEREAS, the total Assessed Values for each of the 2017 and 2018 Tax Years shall be as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Tax Assessor has agreed to the adjustment of the assessed value of the real property for the subject Tax Years in accordance with the settlement; and,

WHEREAS, the agreed upon adjustment of the assessed values have resulted in a total tax recapture by the Taxpayer in the amount of twenty-one thousand three hundred ten dollars and eighty cents (\$21,310.80), which amount shall be refunded; and,

WHEREAS, The Taxpayer has further agreed to waive statutory pre-judgment interest on the tax refund; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town of Secaucus to adjust the Assessed Value on the subject real property in accordance with the terms of settlement set forth herein.

2.01 IN BLOCK 46 AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL TAX MAPS
THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS OWNED BY SINAI ASSOCIATES, INC.

WHEREAS, Sinai Associates, Inc., the owner of real property located at 700 Penhorn Avenue, otherwise designated as Lot 2.01 in Block 46 on the official tax maps of the Town of Secaucus, has taken an appeal to the Tax Court of the State of New Jersey from an Added Assessment levied upon said property in 2015; and

WHEREAS, after extensive discovery the Parties have agreed to rescind the Added Assessment and adjust the real property's Overall Assessed Value accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the Complaint filed in 2016 challenges the Added Assessment of two hundred seventy-five thousand (\$275,000) dollars levied against the property in 2015 and said Complaint has been withdrawn; and

WHEREAS, with the rescission of the Added Assessment, the Town must correct said overbilling of taxes for 2015, 2016 2017 2018 and 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Taxpayer has further agreed to waive statutory pre-judgment interest on the tax refund; and

WHEREAS, the Town Tax Assessor has agreed to the rescission of the Added Assessment on the real property for the years in question in accordance with the settlement; and,

WHEREAS, the agreed upon rescission of the Added Assessment has resulted in a total tax recapture by the Taxpayer for the property in the amount of \$45,358.50; and

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WHEREAS, the total tax refund shall be provided to the Taxpayer as a credit against any unpaid 2020 Taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town of Secaucus to rescind the Added Assessment on the property in accordance with the terms of settlement set forth herein.
