The Division of Transportation Operations Systems and Support, Support Services, is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the New Jersey Department of Transportation's (NJDOT) facilities and grounds statewide, which include the Main Headquarters Complex in Ewing, Regional Headquarters Buildings, Maintenance Yards, Rest Areas, Weigh Stations, Airports, etc. It also provides centralized services, such as: warehouse and shipping, receptionist, cashier, mail room.

Building Maintenance Worker

Starting salary: \$29,817—\$33,691 based on experience

Requirements: No experience or formal education required

Duties include:

- Sweeps sidewalks, removes papers, trash, and weeds from outside grounds. May assist in snow removal
- Rearrange/relocate office furniture, supplies, and records
- Report and/or replace damaged appliance, equipment and supplies
- Repair/replace electric lightbulbs, fuses, locks, window cords, and equipment
- Paint walls, woodwork, and ceilings
- Periodically checks fuel and housekeeping supplies
- Proper use of department equipment, material, and supplies be stored, obtained and safeguarded.

Requirements: One (1) year of experience in working involving the performance of semiskilled grounds keeping work

Automotive Mechanics are assigned a 40 hour work week. They perform maintenance and repair on all fleet (gasoline and diesel) vehicles and equipment used by Maintenance, Electrical and Traffic Systems Management units.

Requirements:

- ◆ Successful completion of (1) year of training in automotive technology at an accredited community college of vocational school
- ◆ Two (2) years of experience as a mechanic in the repair and installation of motors and maintenance and repair of motorized vehicles and equipment
- ◆ Applicants who do not possess the required formal training may substitute one (1) additional year of experience

Safety Service Patrol Apprentice

Starting salary between \$35,369 and \$40,057

NJDOT's Safety Service Patrol provides coverage along 225 linear miles. They assist motorists whose vehicles have become disabled and provide safety for emergency responders. They assist nearly 70,000 customers annually. Assistance includes changing a flat tire, pushing a disabled vehicle off to the shoulder, pulling a vehicle trapped in mud or snow back onto the road, providing a small amount of gasoline and making minor repairs. SSP drivers also assist the New Jersey State Police (NJSP) and other responders by promoting safety and diverting traffic during incidents and creating a safe work zone for emergency responders.
