On May 26, 2016, the Town of Secaucus was presented with an award from the New Jersey Clean Communities Council (NJCCC), "**Don't Waste Our Open Space Award**" for the town's campaign to stop, fine and prevent illegal dumping. This program is a component of a pilot program with the DEP whose goal is to monitor and strengthen our enforcement against illegal dumping.
